Amanda is a Senior Clinical Psychologist and has worked for the past 7 years in a specialist Local Authority Looked After and Adopted Children's Psychology Service. She is highly experienced in working with children, families and those in the care systems around the child using attachment and trauma frameworks to offer assessments and therapeutic intervention. Amanda is currently undertaking Dyadic Developmental Psychotherapy (DDP) training.

Since working for Changing Minds, Amanda has worked therapeutically with children and adults with mental health difficulties. She has also provided post adoption support services funded through the Adoption Support Fund.

Prior to working as a Clinical Psychologist, Amanda worked for the Youth Justice Board supporting the development of offending behaviour programmes in secure and custodial environments. She has also held a Senior Management position (Head of Youth Offending Services) within a custodial setting for young people, managing a multi disciplinary team responsible for psychological intervention (including offence focussed work) within the centre.

Amanda also has a PhD in Forensic Psychology. She is registered as a Practitioner Psychologist with the Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC).
